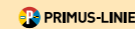
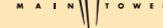
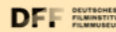

**Valid from 24.07. to 01.09.2023**

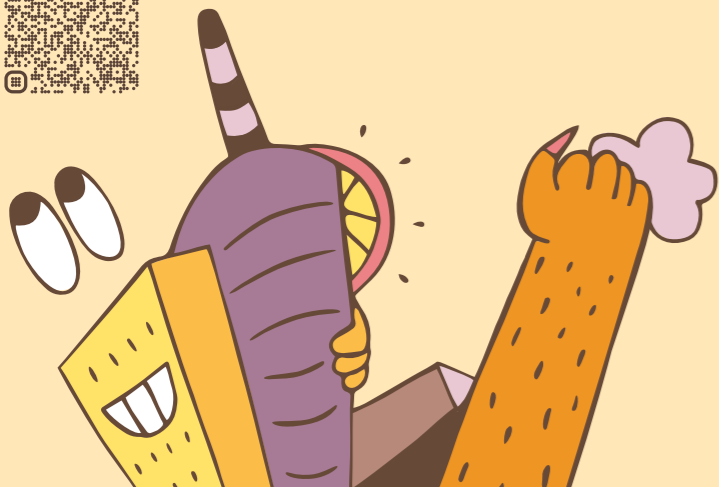
### How much does the Holiday Card cost?

Children and young people with the Frankfurt-Pass get the Holiday Card for free.

- 0 to 14 years: 25,00 € incl. RMV ticket
- 15 to 18 years: 25,00 € incl. swimming pools
- 15 to 18 years: 33,00 € incl. RMV ticket and swimming pools
