Valid from 12 July to 25 August 2024

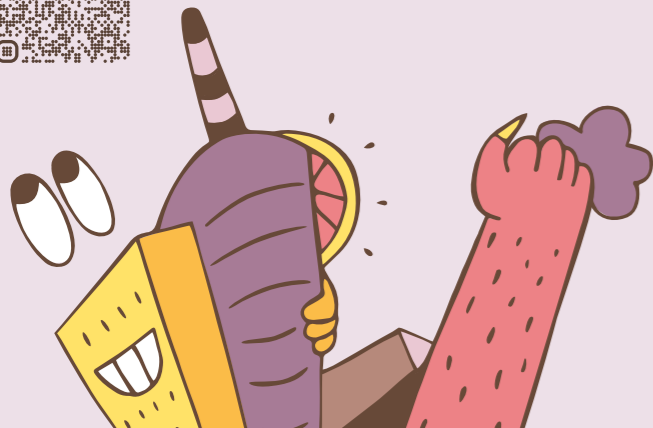
How much does the Holiday Card cost?

Children and young people with a Frankfurt Pass receive the Holiday Card free of charge.

- 3 to 14 years:** € 10.00 without RMV ticket (new)
- 6 to 14 years:** € 25.00 with RMV ticket *
- 15 to 18 years:** € 25.00 without RMV ticket
- 15 to 18 years:** € 33.00 with RMV ticket *

What is the Holiday Card with RMV ticket (bus / train)?

With the RMV ticket on the Holiday Card, you can travel free of charge on public transport - regional bus, city bus, underground, S-Bahn, tram, regional train - in the Frankfurt am Main city area (Frankfurt fare zone including airport, 2nd class, TG 5000).
