For whom is the Holiday Card intended?


Children and youth up to and including 18 years of age with a residential or holiday address in Frankfurt am Main. This is an offer from the Youth and Social Welfare Office.

Valid from 4 July until 17 August 2025

What does the Holiday Card cost?

Children and youth with a Frankfurt Pass receive the Holiday Card free of charge.

3 to 14 years: € 10.00 without RMV ticket 6 to 14 years: € 25,00 incl. RMV-Ticket 14 to 18 years: € 33,00 incl. RMV-Ticket

Payment via PayPal, Paydirekt, Giropay or credit card. Free for Frankfurt Pass holders.

What is the Holiday Card with RMV ticket (bus/train)?

With the RMV ticket add-on to the Holiday Card, you can travel for free on public transport – regional bus, city bus, underground, suburban railway, tram, regional train – in the Frankfurt am Main city area (Frankfurt fare zone incl. airport, 2nd class, TG 5000). The common conditions of carriage and tariff regulations of the RMV apply. The RMV connection ticket regulation is permissible.
